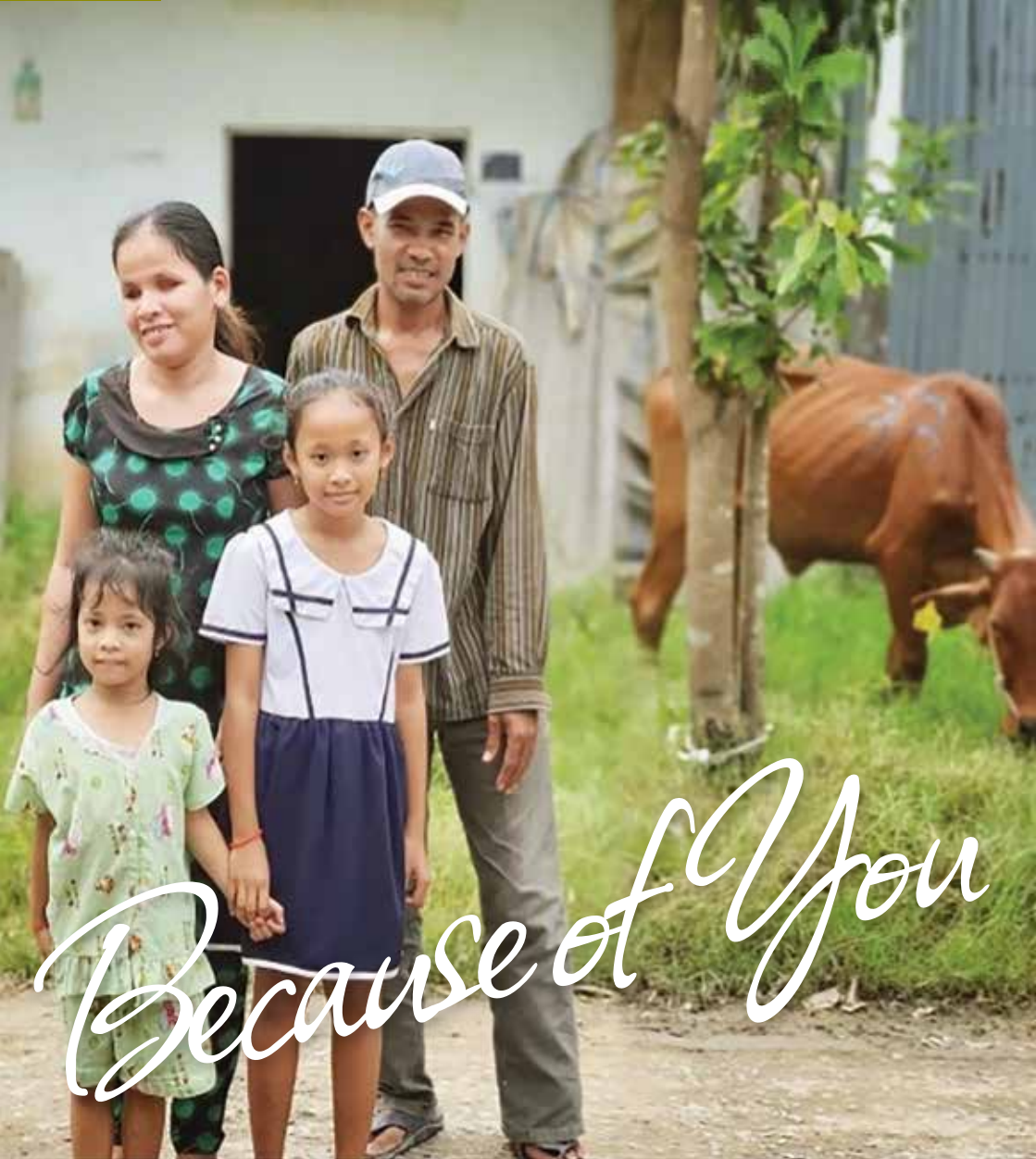

Our Winter Disaster Recovery project and our Community Advancement through Livelihoods for Families project provided opportunities to bring both physical relief and hope in the Name of Jesus Christ to individuals, families and entire villages in need.



COMMUNITY ADVANCEMENT THROUGH LIVELIHOODS FOR FAMILIES (CALF), VIETNAM

THE CALF PROJECT in Vietnam aims to increase household income for vulnerable families through sustainable livelihoods. Last year, the project reached 279 beneficiaries in two communes of Duyen Hai District, Tra Vinh Province. Among these beneficiaries were 70 households who benefited directly from the distribution of cows, training, and agricultural assets. The project provides training on cow husbandry, financial management, cow shelter construction, distribution of grass, fertiliser, cow feed, and cows, as well as training and funding for small businesses to create sustainability and stability.



MR PHUONG AND HIS WIFE, NGA, live in rural Vietnam with their two young daughters. Phuong travels an hour on a motorbike each day to get to work to provide for his family as Nga is blind and is home with their daughters. They were struggling to have enough money to support themselves when Samaritan's Purse selected their family as a recipient of the CALF project. They received a pair of cows to raise to eventually sell. With training and support, Nga has been able to raise healthy cows and has a goal of growing a herd.

She shares, *"I plan to use the money earned from the cow to fund my daughters' education, so that they can have better opportunities to earn a living in the future. Unlike me, I want them to have the ability to take care of themselves. My daughters have a passion for learning, and I want to support and encourage that passion".*

WINTER DISASTER RECOVERY 2023, MONGOLIA

The 2020-2021 winter dzud disaster in Mongolia resulted in over 7 million livestock being lost and leaving over 200,000 rural herdsmen with their livelihoods severely threatened. Through the Winter Disaster Recovery program, Samaritan's Purse was able to help 40 families (200 individuals) in four communities of Arkhangai and Bayankhongor Provinces last year. Each family was given winter resilience training and technical assistance and provided with various agricultural supplies to achieve sustainable livelihoods with reduced livestock loss.



GANTULGA IS 27 YEARS OLD and lives with his mother in Ulziyt Sum, Arkhangai Province. Gantulga grew up raising livestock and received assistance from the Winter Disaster Recovery project.

He shares, *"I am very happy... Last year, I had submitted a request to my village governor and it was about food support. Because we could not make a living with a few animals. I was not sure if I could join any help project. Now, I am a beneficiary of a livelihood project, not food aid, and even more fortunate. Currently, It's cold -40 this winter, but I've prepared well for the winter and we've got enough hay for our animals, so there's nothing to worry about."*
