WHAT IS OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD (OCC)?

Operation Christmas Child is a project of Samaritan's Purse, an international relief organisation. This project is a hands-on way for you to bless children in need across the world by filling shoeboxes with toys, hygiene items, school supplies, and fun gifts.

We collect the gift-filled shoeboxes and send them to local partners around the world that use them as a means of reaching out to children in their own communities with the Good News of Jesus Christ. After receiving gift-filled shoeboxes, many children are invited to participate in The Greatest Journey discipleship program and millions of children each year are making decisions to follow Christ (see below for more information).

Since 1993, more than **198 million** children in more than 170 countries and territories have received an Operation Christmas Child shoebox. The project delivers not only the joy of what, for many kids, is their first gift ever, but also gives them a tangible expression of God's love.

In 2021, Australia and New Zealand sent **210,182** shoeboxes to Cambodia, Fiji, Solomon Islands, Madagascar, Nauru and Papua New Guinea. Globally, there were more than **10.5 million** shoeboxes collected and sent to over 100 countries and territories.

All of Samaritan's Purse's projects, including OCC, are given and provided with "no strings attached" and without regard to the race, creed, gender, religion or ethnicity of the beneficiaries.

WHAT IS THE GREATEST JOURNEY (TGJ)?

The Greatest Journey is a 12-lesson discipleship course offered by local churches to many of the children who receive shoebox gifts. Children who participate in the program learn how to follow Christ and share Him with others. As they do, entire families and communities are transformed by the power of the Gospel, and churches are started. Nearly **31 million** children have enrolled in this program since 2009.

A GRADUATION CELEBRATION

After completing The Greatest Journey, children attend a graduation celebration and receive a certificate. Most importantly, they are given a Bible that includes the New Testament and selected Old Testament stories along with a dictionary of Biblical terms and a map of Bible lands. Complete with illustrations, it is often the first copy of God's Word the child, or their family, will own. Family and friends who attend the ceremony hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Hearing the Good News and testimonies during their loved one's graduation reinforces the changes they have seen in the students' lives, and their families often come to faith in Christ.

BELIEVERS MULTIPLY

Since 2009, more than **15 million** children have reported decisions for Christ while taking The Greatest Journey. These children as well as those who hear the Gospel at shoebox outreach events share their faith with friends and family—who in turn disciple others.





HOW TO PACK AN OCC SHOEBOX

- **1. SHOEBOX:** Order your pre-printed shoeboxes online or use a regular size shoebox with lid no larger than an A4 page.
- 2. GIFTS: Choose a boy or girl and age group (2-4, 5-9 or 10-14) and fill your shoebox with gifts.
- **3. DONATE:** A donation of \$10 per box is essential to cover shipping and other project costs. For easiest processing, you can give online through <u>operationchristmaschild.org.au</u>, or you can give by completing the form in the 'How to Pack' brochure and enclose in your shoebox gift. If you use the online option, you can 'Follow Your Box' and discover the destination of your gift.
- **4. LABEL:** Every shoebox gift must be clearly labelled. Visit the Donations & Labels page at <u>operationchristmaschild.org.au</u> to order your labels when you make your \$10 donation, or use the label included in The 'How to Pack' brochure. Please ensure the label clearly indicates if you packed for a boy or girl and which age category, then stick it on your shoebox!
- **5. PRAY:** Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your shoebox gift and for their family and community to be transformed by the Gospel.
- **6. DROP-OFF:** Take your shoebox gift to a local drop-off location during National Collection, 17-31 October. Visit the OCC website to find one near you.

If you are unable to pack a shoebox, we are pleased to share that you can Pack A Shoebox Online without leaving your home! For just \$30 you can select a shoebox to be packed for a boy or girl and age group, and we will pack and send the shoebox for you.

HOW TO PACK A SHOEBOX ONLINE:

- **1.** Visit <u>operationchristmaschild.org.au</u> or <u>operationchristmaschild.org.nz</u> and select "Pack A Shoebox Online" from the main menu.
- **2.** Choose to pack for a boy or girl, select an age category, and add the quantity of shoeboxes. Then write your child a letter in the box provided.
- **3.** Proceed to the checkout to complete your order.
- **4.** Once you have completed your order we will print your letter, pack your shoebox and send it to a child for you! We want everyone to have the opportunity to bless a child!
